

GDPR Privacy Statement for Contractors of Moundsmere Estate Management Ltd

As a business providing farm and estate management and property letting and management services it is necessary for us to hold and retain personal information for contractors to carry out services for us and on behalf of our clients.

We may hold names, addresses, date of births, phone numbers, email addresses, bank account & insurance details and other information as necessary.

Under the GDPR the lawful bases for this information being held are:

Contract: managing the information we need to retain to do business with you. These may include contact details, insurance details, trade references and financial information such as bank details

Legal Obligation; storing copies of your information to comply with the requirements of statutory bodies.

We will only hold contractors' data for as long as it is required or we are legally obliged to do so. We will hold your records on file for no more than 5 years after your last work with us ended except for records we are legally required to keep for longer. Out of date files are shredded in our office or disposed of by a reputable document disposal company.
