

## **GDPR Privacy Statement for Clients of Moundsmere Estate Management Ltd**

As a business providing services including farm and estate management and advice and providing bookkeeping services it is necessary for us to hold and retain personal information for our clients and their employees to carry out the services we provide for you.

We may hold names, addresses, date of births, phone numbers, email addresses, bank account & insurance details and other information as necessary.

Under the GDPR the lawful bases for this information being held are:

**Contract:** carrying out the tasks we are obliged to do on your behalf ie daily administration, the processing and payment of invoices, payroll services.

**Legal Obligation**; storing books and records to comply with the requirements of statutory bodies, dealing with government agencies on your behalf.

In addition we may use a third party provider, Mailchimp, for storing your email address only for communicating with you by newsletter, we also use a third party provider, Catalyst2 for our website which uses cookies. These platforms which comply with the GDPR regulations.

We will only hold personal data for as long as it is required or we are legally obliged to do so. Out of date files are shredded in our office or disposed of by a reputable document disposal company.
